Allied Health and Human Services
Emergency Services Option
(EDGE/Cooperative Program with Career/Technical Centers)**

The Associate in Applied Science in Allied Health and Human Services: Emergency Services Option is an EDGE/collaborative program between WVSCCTC and Career/Technical Centers. Students who complete the Emergency Services Program and transfer to WVSCCTC will be granted 22 credit hours toward the A.A.S. in Allied Health and Human Services: Emergency Services Option upon completion of all courses in the program and a passing score of 75% or above on the state exam.

Careers in Emergency Services

The program primarily prepares the graduates for employment and/or further on-the-job training in assisting with patient-care in medical, fire, water, and trauma emergencies, and laboratory duties. Typical locations for graduates of this program may include fire services, clinics, 911 dispatch centers, and other medical facilities.

Program Learning Outcomes

These learning outcomes are established for the Emergency Services Program at the associate degree level. Upon completion of this program the student will be able to:

1. Obtain appropriate employment as an Emergency Services Technician.
2. Adapt to emerging and rapid changes in science, technology, or human health services.
3. Assist in a fire fighting condition.
4. Assist with emergency diagnosis treatment, and care for injuries.
5. Assist in the clinical procedures.
6. Assist in telecommunications in the dispatching profession.
7. Perform administrative duties.
